The “Popping” Sound

Manner:

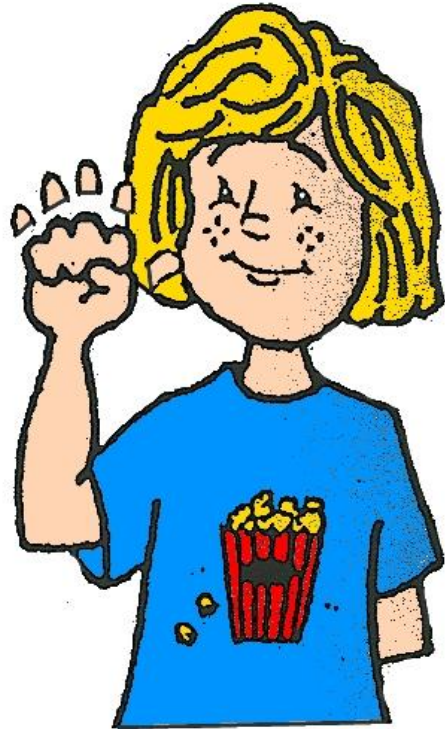
Plosive - A consonant that is produced by stopping the airflow using the lips, teeth, or palate, followed by a sudden release of air.

Place:

Bilabial – Produced with both lips

Voicing:

Voice is turned off



Visual Cue:

Hold your right hand in a fist, palm out, and pop your fingers open as you say /p/.

Verbal Cue:

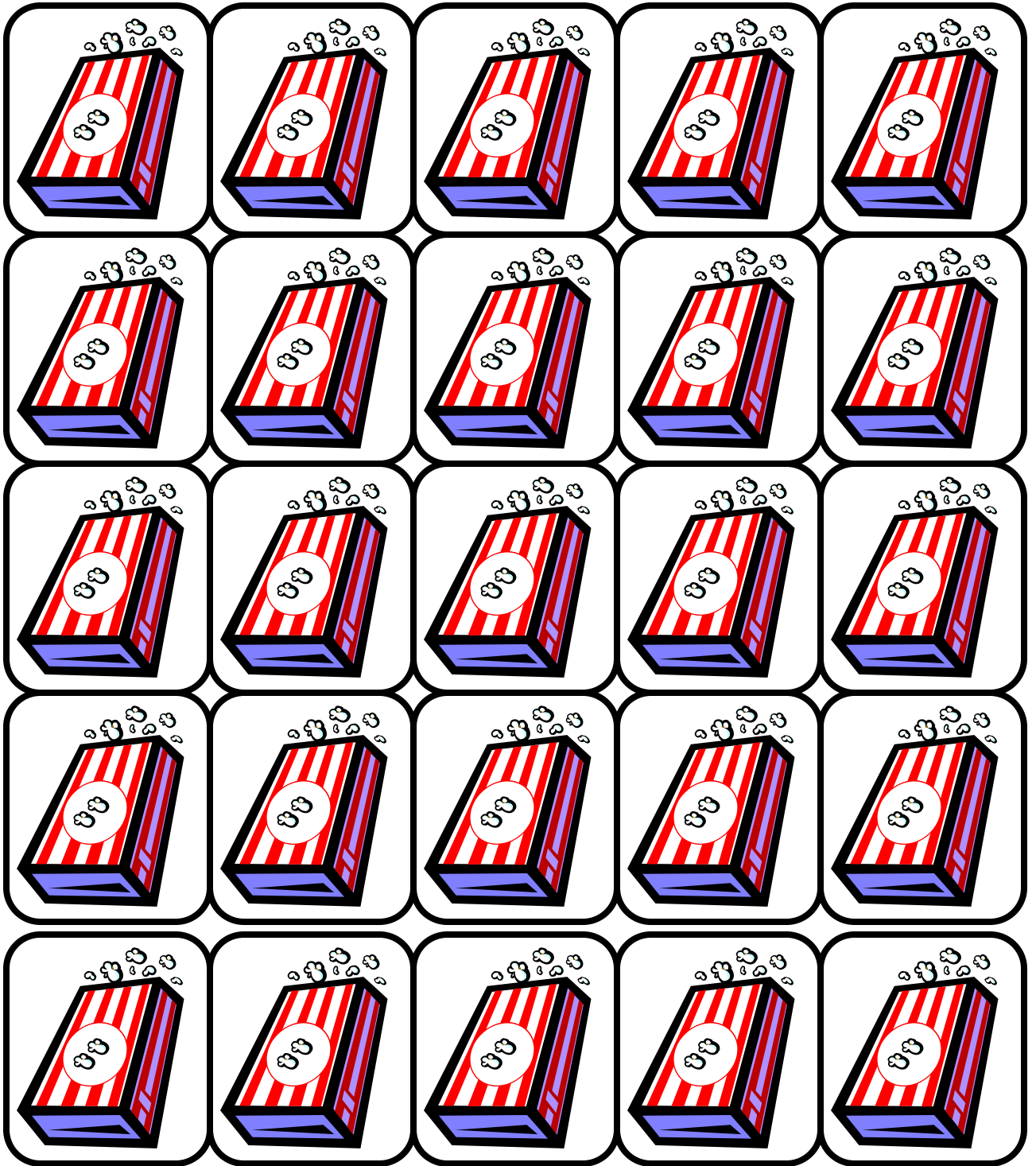
“Close your lips together, build up your air inside your mouth, and pop the air out by opening up your lips quickly and blowing out.”
